The Motor Vessel Grand Manan II. connects beautiful Grand Manan Island, in the Bay of Fundy, with Saint John, Saint Stephen, Saint Andrews and Eastport, Maine.

This is a short picturesque salt water sail on a vessel of liner type.

From Saint Andrews the steamer sails through beautiful Passamaquoddy Bay, calling at Campobello Island and Eastport en route to Grand Manan.

The Island of Grand Manan is nine miles from the mainland. It is twenty-one miles long and nine miles wide.

Rugged cliffs and bold headlands separated by sandy beaches and beautiful coves make this truly an Island Gem.

There are many opportunities for boating, bathing and fishing.

The hospitality of the people of Grand Manan assures the visitor of a warm welcome at any of the various Inns and Hotels.
